A. COOKIE POLICY

This website uses cookies and similar technologies such as pixel tags, web beacons, clear GIFs, JavaScript, and local storage. Cookies are small files – usually consisting of letters and numbers – placed on your computer, tablet, phone, or similar device, when you use that device to visit a website. We will refer to cookies and similar technologies simply as “Cookies” for the remainder of this Cookie Policy. We use cookies to enable our servers to recognize your web browser and tell us how and when you visit and otherwise access our website through the internet, to analyze trends, and to learn about our user base.

We may combine non-personally identifiable information collected through cookies with other personal information that we have about you, for example, to tell us who you are or whether you have an account. We may also supplement the information we collect from you with information received from third parties in order to enhance our Services or to offer you information that we believe may be of interest to you. Where we use Cookies to collect information that is personally identifiable or that can become personally identifiable if we combine it with other information, the [Ancillaries Media Privacy Policy](#) will apply in addition to this Cookie Policy.

You can control and/or delete cookies as you wish – for details, see www.aboutcookies.org. Most browsers have an option for turning off the cookie feature, which will prevent your browser from accepting new cookies, as well as (depending on the sophistication of your browser software) allowing you to decide on acceptance of each new cookie in a variety of ways. You can delete all cookies that are already on your computer and you can set most browsers to prevent them from being placed. If you do this, however, you may have to manually adjust some preferences every time you visit a site and some services and functionalities may not work. B. WHAT TYPES OF COOKIES DO WE USE AND FOR WHICH PURPOSES?

We use the following types of Cookies:

Analytical Cookies

These Cookies allow us to understand how visitors use our site. This includes information about the number of visitors to the site, what pages visitors view on our site, and how long visitors are viewing pages on the site. Analytical Cookies also help us measure the performance of our advertising campaigns in order to help us improve our advertising campaigns and to optimize our Services' content for those who engage with our advertising.

C. WHAT IS THE GOOGLE ANALYTICS COOKIE AND HOW IS IT USED?

Our Services use Google Analytics, a web analysis service provided by Google Inc. (“Google”) which is based on Cookie technology. The information generated by the Cookie is usually sent to a Google server in the USA, where it is stored. Because IP anonymization is activated on this website, your IP address is abbreviated after being received by Google. Google will use the

generated information to evaluate your use of the website, to compile reports on website activities, and to provide the website operator with additional services connected with website and Internet use. The IP address transmitted by your browser in connection with Google Analytics is not collated with other data by Google.
